In re Complaint of Jane Doe¹

ORDER

This is a judicial complaint filed against the chief judge of this Circuit, two other members of the court, and three United States district judges. The complaint alleges a litany of alleged judicial misconduct on the part of these judges, including allegations of ethnic discrimination, conspiracy with mob organizations, and similar acts. These allegations are so facially incredible or so lacking in indicia of reliability that no further inquiry is warranted, and thus they will be dismissed as frivolous. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(iii), and Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings of the Judicial Conference of the United States (J.C.U.S.) Rule 11(c)(1)(C).

To the extent that complainant's allegations are directly related to the merits of the complained-against judges' decisions or procedural rulings, they will be dismissed for that reason. See 28 U.S.C. § 352(b)(1)(A)(ii) and J.C.U.S. Rule 3(h)(3)(A).

¹Under Rule 4(f)(1) of the Rules Governing Complaints of Judicial Misconduct and Disability of the Eighth Circuit, the names of the complainant and the judicial officer complained against are to remain confidential, except in special circumstances not here present.

The complaint is dismissed in its entirety.
