In re Complaint of John Doe<sup>1</sup>

Before me is what purports to be a judicial complaint against the chief judge of this Circuit. In essence, however, the complaint alleges that the chief judge erred in dismissing the complaint that complainant had filed against a United States district judge, the remedy for which is a petition for review under Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings of the Judicial Conference of the United States, Rule 18.

Accordingly, the purposed complaint is rejected and returned to the clerk of the court with directions to close it and refile it in the original complaint proceedings as a petition for review.

It is so ordered.
