**State of Texas' Supplement to Its Response in Opposition to
Request to Participate in Oral Argument by
Amicus Curiae City of Las Cruces**

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April 28, 2015

On April 24, 2015, the State of Texas filed a Response in Opposition to Request to Participate in Oral Argument by *Amicus Curiae* City of Las Cruces (Response). The State of Texas respectfully supplements its Response because it mistakenly states that El Paso County Water Improvement District No. 1 (EPCWID) did not file an amicus brief on New Mexico's motion to dismiss. Response at 2. EPCWID filed an amicus brief in support of the State of Texas and United States in opposition to New Mexico's motion to dismiss on June 16, 2014.¹ Notwithstanding EPCWID's filing of that amicus brief, the City of Las Cruces' reference to EPCWID counsel's comments do not, in any way, affect the capacity of the State of New Mexico to represent its citizens, which include the City, on its motion to dismiss.
