CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 2

A status conference was conducted by telephone on January 6, 2015. For the purposes of the proceedings before the Special Master, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. New Mexico's Request for Modification or Supplementation of Case Management Order No. 1

The Special Master granted New Mexico's Request as to the introduction of parties and as to the revision of the Distribution List for Service of Documents.

2. Fees and Expenses of the Special Master and Staff

The parties did not object to the proposed hourly rates of the Special Master and his staff; therefore, the following rates will apply: \$400 per hour for the Special Master; \$300 per hour for Patrick M. Shelby and Meredith S. Grabill; \$125 per hour for paralegal services; and \$350 per hour for consultant Professor Gregg M. Maggs.

The parties likewise did not object to the proposed procedure for payment of the Special Master's fees and expenses; therefore, the Special Master will file with the Clerk of the Supreme Court of the United States a motion for allowance of fees and disbursements not sooner than every six months, with copies of those motions to be served on the parties by the Special Master.

All parties are to attempt to achieve an amicable agreement as to the percentage of fees and expenses to be paid by each party. The parties are to notify the Special Master of any such agreement by means of a joint or consent motion.

3. Rules governing these proceedings

The parties are to adhere to the form of pleadings and motions prescribed by the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. In all other matters, the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and the Federal Rules of Evidence presumptively apply. However, it is not necessary at this time for the parties to provide Rule 26 disclosures.

4. Methods for filing and service

All documents shall be filed with the Special Master as set forth in Case Management Order No. 1. Filings will be deemed to have been filed and served on the date that they are emailed to the Special Master, whose docket sheet will reflect that date for each filing.

The parties shall serve individuals on the Distribution List for Service of Documents attached hereto as Appendix A, which reflects the information provided by the parties. Service will be made electronically with one hard copy to be served on each party. Any party that has

not done so is ordered to submit to the Special Master and to all parties a list of e-mail and physical addresses for those individuals upon whom that party wishes all filings to be served.

All pleadings, papers, and other documents submitted to the Special Master must indicate, in the certificate of service or elsewhere, the means by which service or transmittal has been accomplished.

5. Venue for conferences and proceedings

All conferences and proceedings shall be conducted in New Orleans, Louisiana, either in the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals or in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Louisiana, as will be indicated in any Case Management Order setting the conference or hearing.

6. New Mexico's Motion To Dismiss/Comprehensive Case Management Plan

In view of New Mexico's pending motion to dismiss the claims of Texas and of the United States, and as the parties have agreed, it is not necessary at this time for the parties to prepare a draft comprehensive case management plan.

7. Participation of Nonparties in Conferences and Proceedings

Unless ordered otherwise for a particular proceeding, nonparties may attend conferences and proceedings in this matter. Any nonparty wishing to attend by listening in to a telephone conference should inform the office of the Special Master by e-mail at least twenty-four hours in advance of the telephone conference.

8. Requests for Modification or Supplementation

Any requests for modification or supplementation of this Case Management Order should be received by the Special Master on or before Friday, February 27, 2015.
