PER CURIAM.

Tommie Thompson appeals his drug-related convictions. On appeal, Thompson contends the evidence is insufficient to support his convictions. We disagree. We believe a discussion of Thompson's fact-specific arguments would serve no useful purpose. We thus affirm Thompson's convictions without further discussion. See 8th Cir. R. 47B.
