PER CURIAM.

Sandra Dunbar appeals the district court's¹ judgment in favor of defendant following a bench trial in her wrongful-death suit. After careful consideration of the arguments in Dunbar's brief, we conclude that the district court's judgment should be affirmed. Dunbar fails to direct us to anything in the record which would show that the district court erred in entering judgment against her after finding no evidence of

negligence. See United States v. Wicker, 80 F.3d 263, 268 (8th Cir. 1996) (district court's findings as to credibility of witnesses are virtually unreviewable on appeal).

Accordingly, we affirm. See 8th Cir. R. 47B.
