PER CURIAM.

Jesus Ibarra-Torres appeals the district court's¹ denial of his 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) sentence-reduction motion. Having carefully reviewed the record, we agree with the district court that Ibarra-Torres is not entitled to a sentence reduction based on Amendment 484 to the Sentencing Guidelines because it was in effect when Ibarra-Torres was sentenced. See U.S.S.G. App. C, amend. 484; United States v. Alvarez, 210 F.3d 309, 310 (5th Cir. 2000) (per curiam).
