PER CURIAM.

Michael O’Grady appeals the district court’s¹ judgment dismissing his civil rights complaint. Having carefully considered O’Grady’s arguments on appeal, and upon de novo review, we conclude that dismissal was proper. We agree with the district court that O’Grady either failed to state a claim with regard to his allegations

related to child custody and child support enforcement, or failed to assert a basis for federal subject matter jurisdiction. Accordingly, we affirm. *See* 8th Cir. R. 47B. The pending motions are denied.
