PER CURIAM.

Muhammed Tillisy appeals the district court's¹ dismissal of his 28 U.S.C. § 2241 petition challenging the Bureau of Prisons' denial of his request for compassionate release. We dismiss the appeal as moot, because Tillisy was released from custody on March 30, 2009. See Calderon v.
