PER CURIAM.

In this 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action, former inmate Michael B. Mosley appeals from the order of the District Court¹ granting summary judgment to defendants. Viewing the record in the light most favorable to Mosley and drawing all reasonable inferences in his favor, we conclude that the record did not establish a deliberate-indifference claim. See Peterson v. Kopp, 754 F.3d 594, 598 (8th Cir. 2014) (standard of review). We affirm the judgment and deny as moot Mosley's pending motion for judicial notice.
