In this 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action, Arkansas inmate Anthony Fowlkes appeals the district court's<sup>1</sup> adverse grant of summary judgment. Taking all the evidence and reasonable inferences in Fowlkes's favor, see Faulkner v. Douglas Cty.
