PER CURIAM.

Goaner R. Weang, a citizen of South Sudan, appeals the district court's<sup>1</sup> order dismissing, without prejudice, his 28 U.S.C. § 2241 petition. Upon careful de novo review, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. See *Zadvydas v. Davis*, 533 U.S. 678, 699, 701 (2001); *Ufele v. Holder*, 473 Fed. Appx. 144, 146 (3d Cir. 2012); see also *Abdullah v. Hedrick*, 392 F.3d 957, 959 (8th Cir. 2004) (standard of review). Accordingly, appellees' motion to supplement the record is granted, and the judgment of the district court is affirmed. See 8th Cir. R. 47B.
