Calvertson Slim, who was civilly committed pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 4246 in 2019, appeals the district court's<sup>1</sup> order revoking his grant of conditional release

under section 4246(f). After careful review of the record and the parties' arguments on appeal, we conclude that the district court did not clearly err in finding that Slim failed to comply with his prescribed regimen of care and that his continued release would therefore create a substantial risk of bodily injury to another person or serious damage to property of another. See 18 U.S.C. § 4246(f); United States v. Burleson, 29 Fed. App'x 412, 413 (8th Cir. 2002) (unpublished per curiam) (standard of review). Accordingly, we affirm. See 8th Cir. R. 47B.
