PER CURIAM.

Jose Rojas appeals after he pleaded guilty to an illegal reentry offense and the district court<sup>1</sup> imposed a within-Guidelines sentence. His counsel has moved for

leave to withdraw, and has filed a brief under *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), challenging the sentence as substantively unreasonable.

After careful review, we conclude that the district court did not abuse its discretion in sentencing Rojas. *See United States v. Feemster*, 572 F.3d 455, 461 (8th Cir. 2009) (en banc) (standard of review); *United States v. Callaway*, 762 F.3d 754, 760 (8th Cir. 2014) (stating that a sentence within the Guidelines is presumed to be reasonable). We have also independently reviewed the record under *Penon v. Ohio*, 488 U.S. 75 (1988), and have found no non-frivolous issues for appeal.

Accordingly, we affirm the judgment, and we grant counsel leave to withdraw.
